Rallye Sanremo starts spring

Long steps lead toward the race, second round of the Italian Rally Championship and of the Italian Historic Cars Championship that's taking place from 11th to 14th of April. There will be also the Sanremo Leggenda, the regularity race Flowers Cup and the ECO Rally reserved to alternative powered cars. The novelty is the super special stage at Porto Sole that's going to take place at 15h45 on Friday April 13th.

SANREMO (IM) – Spring is late? No worries, the 65th edition of Rallye Sanremo will drive away clouds and rain. The race will take place from Wednesday April 11th till Saturday April 14th in the Town of Flowers. Also this year the rallying appointment on the West coast Riviera will have on the roads of the Liguria hinterland cars that will take part in five different races: The 65th Rallye Sanremo is valid for the Italian Rally Championship, the Italian Asphalt Championship, Italian 2WD Championship, Suzuki Rally Trophy and the two trophies of Renault (Clio R3 Top, this year open also to the Clio R3T, and R1 Top. Together with the modern cars will take place the 33rd Sanremo Historic Rallye valid for the Italian Historic Cars Championship, followed by the 32nd edition of the Flowers Cup, traditional regularity race that will see at the start the most beautiful historic cars.

In these past ten years the Organizers offer the possibility to dispute a less demanding "Sanremo", but nevertheless not less exciting and spectacular. This is the Sanremo Leggenda 10th edition that will be concentrated on Saturday April 14th. Last but not least "Sanremo" looks at the future with the third edition of the ECO Rally reserved to alternative powered cars.

The next steps before the engines will be turned on are the closing of entries, on Thursday April 5th and the scrutineering and sporting checks on Wednesday April 11th and Thursday April 12th. Adrenaline will rise on Friday April 13th with the start of the first competitor from Piazza Colombo, the heart of the town, at 15h36 to head towards Porto Sole for the 2.56 km long super special stage. After that the long "Sanremo" night will start with the traditional passes on SS Vignai, Bignone and San Romolo, followed by the "Mini Ronde" 29,12 km long to be run all at once and the first day will be closed just after midnight with the repetition of SS San Romolo. Saturday April 14th the second day with the SS Testico, San Bartolomeo and Colle d'Oggia. The final arrival will be at 19h00 in Piazza Colombo to discover the winner of the 65th edition of Rallye Sanremo.

The sun has already reserved its room in the Town of Flowers to enjoy 65th Rallye Sanremo in the first row.
